


blind spots ...?




46% of persons with extensive physical disabilities report that their **health condition** is "poor" or "very poor".

Among persons without disabilities, the figure is 1%



27.6% of persons with extensive physical disabilities have primary school as their highest level **of education**. For persons without disabilities, the figure is 9.4%



29% of persons with an extensive mental disability and 43.5% of persons with extensive physical disability are on **the labor market**.

72.6% of persons without disabilities are on the labor market.



32.5% of persons with extensive mental disability and 41.4% of persons with extensive physical disability find that they can **use buses and trains** without difficulty. For people without disabilities, the figure is 86%

Universal design means the design of **products**, **environments**, **programmes** and **services** to be usable by all people, to the greatest extent possible, without the need for adaptation or specialized design.

Universal design shall not exclude assistive devices for particular groups of persons with disabilities where this is needed.
